
Machinery Regulation Editorial Group

Machinery Experts Group Meeting 07 November 2025

Purpose & Organization

Review and approve proposals for updating the current Machinery Directive Guideline to incorporate, where necessary, clarification of the legal text, specifically for newly introduced essential technical requirements in MR Annex III.



Sub-Group: 1 Leader: NL - Simone Wiers

Status

• Topic: NLF provisions, ergonomics, substantialm modifications, overall fitness check

• Members: 70

• SG Leader is mapping all input and creating packages based on the chapters in the Regulation

Next Steps

- 2 meetings foreseen before end of 2025 (dates to be confirmed)
 - Information on topics to be discussed during each meeting will be shared to support experts to decide if/when participation is necessary (based on their expertise)

Sub-Group: 2 Leader: IT – Stefano Boy

Status

• Topic: Al powered safety functions, software as safety components

• Members: 41

- A consolidated document, based on available proposals and written comments on these, has been prepared and circulated to the SG for commenting (including technical argumentation)
 - Commenting period for SG members untill 26 Nov

Next Steps

- 3 drafting teams to be established (to be announced 17 Nov)
 - Each will produce a draft text by 12 Jan 2026; which will be shared for commenting to all SG members

Others

- SG Leader requested volunteer to support as a secretary for the SG
 - Candidates to indicate willingness by 17 Nov.

Sub-Group: 3 Leader: FR – Laurent Garrouste

Status

- Topic: seating/restraint system, OHL, autonomous mobile machinery
- Members: 46
- 2 meetings held (02/10, 05/11)
- Focus on seating/restrain systems
- Work is done using a consolidated proposal and comments made on this consolidated version

Next Steps

- Next meetings scheduled for 10/12, 28/01
- Target is to have a final proposal on seating ready by end Jan, 2026
- Next topic will be OHL

Sub-Group: 4 Leader: ORGALIM – David Main-Reade

Status

• Topic: protection against corruption

• Members: 33

• 3 meetings held (10/11, 07/10, 05/11)

• A consolidated document (based on various proposals (industry, member states and members feedback) is being used

Next Steps

- Continue with monthly meeting (next meeting dates to be announced)
- Target is to have a final proposal ready by end Feb 2026

Sub-Group: 5

Leader: EGMF – Giovanni D'Arezzo

Status

• Topic: digital documentation

• Members: 35

• 2 meetings held (26/09, 30/10)

- various proposals (i.e. industry, member states) and members feedback issued
- Group agreed to work on ORGALIM document (most matured/complete proposal)

Next Steps

- Next meeting scheduled for 24/11
- 3 more monthly meetings are considered for 2026
- Target is to have a final proposal ready by end Mar 2026

Other Issues

- Certain input is outside the scope of SG-5; these will be consolidated and shared with SG-1
- Some input is targetting to change the legal text (meaning); these will be disregarded.

Conclusion

- Work has been initiated, meetings are set (or will be announced soon)
- Limited experts are reacting/issueing proposals/comments
- Expect first drafts to be transfered to Editorial Group by Feb 2026
- * Regular coordination with Sub-Group Leaders
- Editorial Group Leadership will meet end Jan 2026
 - to review status and set a plan/schedule for 2026
